PATAKA

A review of the Pataka system is still in progress, options will be discussed at the fisheries wananga in Masterton.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The Scholarship review is also in progress with the board confirming research and general scholarships as a priority targeting territory students competing degrees and/or post graduate study.

EVENTS

A presentation was given by Te Rangi Huata regarding the proposed 2011 Kahungunu Day Waitangi Day be mounted as a twilight and day event split between two venues, the Hawke's Bay Sports Park and Farndon Park, Clive.

MRB/TU MAI REVIEW

Members of the MRB provided an update on the Tu Mai Review. Endorsement was also received from the Iwi Board on the proposed Kahungunu Health Priorities which included Cancer, Smoking, Diabetes, Drug and Alcohol abuse, Obesity and Whaioranga (mental health).

KAI IN THE BAY PRESENTATION

R Waitiri & S Jones gave a presentation on the Kai in the Bay Event that was held in Ahuriri. They advised that this would be an annual event.

KEY PRIORITIES DISCUSSION

The Board looked at what areas and key priorities could be for 2010-2011. Some of these items were Cultural Centre, Waka Hourua, Reo Strategy, Improve Communications, Rangatahi, Fisheries, Environment, Political. This will be addressed further at the board planning wananga scheduled for February next year.
