NETBALL RULES

Rule 1 The Team

- The game is played between 2 teams consisting of maximum of 10 players and a minimum of 7 players one of whom is team captain.
- No injury time, sub on and off during the game.
- Mixed teams may have up to 3 male players on court at any time of the game in different thirds.
- Teams must supply their own emergency kit and ice pack.

Rule 2 Duration of the Game

- This is up to the discretion of the **organisers** and the number of teams that enter this competition. This information will be on the draw – available from the iwi website on the 2 February 2012. Quick change over at half time.

Rule 3 Playing equipment

- Teams are responsible to provide their own set of playing bibs for their team.
- Players must wear non-marking soft soled court shoes and not gumboots, jandals or touch shoes.
- Players must ensure their fingernails are cut short and jewelry of any kind is not worn except a **FLAT** wedding band and medical alert jewelry and they **MUST** be taped. Visible piercing that cannot be removed must be fully taped. Cultural necklaces that cannot be removed must be taped to the body under a playing shirt.
- No peaked hats, caps and beanies are to be worn on court.

Rule 4 Team captains/team/players

- Team captains must fill out team sheet once.
- **Team** captains of each team in every game have the right to speak or discuss with the umpire at the end of each game **ONLY** clarifying any rulings or mis-understanding penalties that's made by the umpire and not to question a ruling e.g. "Can you please clarify the penalty that my players are making?"
- Teams must have playing shirts of the same colour to distinguish their team uniform.
- Team captains must have already tossed for first centre pass off and notify the umpires and scorers.

Rule 5 Umpires (Umpire must have the knowledge of the game).

- Umpires are responsible for collecting, checking and returning score cards. Cards are to be entering only at the beginning of the teams' first game only. Names must be checked off. Teams can have up to 10 names on list.
- Umpires must be wearing something comfortable and that are recognized by teams.

Rule 6 Fees

- There is no fee to register a team. There is no winning fee but a presentation will be made. This Tournament reflects the 'Togetherness of our Community at large'
