Opening welcome to Kahungunu whānau

Kōrero

Whānau invited to share their thoughts, worries and solutions regarding the current governments policy programme and its real or potential impact on iwi/Māori. Whānau advised that any motions tabled and agreed will be passed on to the Ngāti Kahungunu Iwi Incorporated (NKII) Board to inform their plan of actions to take to the hui call by the Kīngitanga scheduled for January 2024.

Summary of Motions

- 1. We as Kahungunu will not be dictated to by a political party. Kahungunu will be determining our own strategy in response to the Governments attacks on te iwi Māori. Moved by Te-O-Tāne Huata, seconded by Johnny Nepia Apatu passed by all.
- 2. Calling on Ngāti Kahungunu to support the claim laid by Allan Brown with the Waitangi Tribunal. Moved by Allan Brown, seconded by Rob Whaitri, passed by all.
- 3. Ngāti Kahungunu support Māori wards, moved by Thompson Hokianga, seconded by Alayna Hokianga and passed by all.
- 4. Ngāti Kahungunu provide resource to provide Te Tiriti o Waitangi me Te Whakaputanga education/training. Moved by Tere Harrison and seconded by Mere Ruru, passed by all.
- 5. Ngāti Kahungunu take to government "if you want one people, one nation" then let that nation be Māori. Moved by Evelyn Ratima, seconded by Jerry Hapuku and passed by all.
- 6. Te Aka Charitable Trust is requesting lwi get behind them to save 59 Marine Parade (Conservation house. Moved by Sarah Greening, seconded by Stephanie [Name], passed by all.

- 27. Implement along with our education plan to include education on the doctrine of discovery.
- 28. Each Iwi provides cultural safety for kaimahi working in government.
- 29. Establish a body that has eyes on policies, bills, and legislation.

1. Te-O-Tane Huata

Political and cultural leverage

Tino rangatiratanga – recognising and returning to our ancestral roles, like restoring the mana of wāhine.

Motion:

We as Kahungunu will not be dictated to by a political party. Kahungunu will be determining our own strategy in response to the Government's attacks on te iwi Māori. Moved by Te-O-Tāne Huata, seconded by Johnny Nepe Apatu — passed by all.

2. Allan Brown

Decision-making in communities and supported by the government, not the other way around.

Inequities within Crown agencies go on to create inequality.

Claim laid with Waitangi Tribunal and tabled to Iwi today.

They rob us of our reo, our dialect, our korero and our matauranga which is resulting in unsociable behaviour. We are seeing the results of an inadequate government.

Motion:

Calling on Ngāti Kahungunu to support the claim laid by Allan Brown with the Waitangi Tribunal. Moved by Allan Brown, seconded by Rob Whaitiri, passed by all.

3. Thompson Hokianga

Māori wards policy seeks to remove co-governance and reinstall referendums on Māori wards.

Motion:

Ngāti Kahungunu support Māori wards, Ngāti Kahungunu support Māori wards, moved by Thompson Hokianga, seconded by Alayna Hokianga and passed by all.

4. Warena Wainohu

Ko te amorangi ki mua, iwi leaders, to stand strong and push Kahungunu kaupapa with the unreserved support by all of us who are Ngāti Kahungunu, te hāpai ō ki muri.

Use our language in our whare.

Love and care for our tamariki.

Walk the talk and be authentic.

5. Tere Harrison

Education and collectivism

Motion:

Create resources that provide Te Tiriti o Waitangi me He Whakaputanga education training. Moved by Tere Harrison and seconded by Mere Ruru, passed by all.

6. Johnny Nepe Apatu

Ngā rangatahi everything you have learned, put it into action. If you don't share your thoughts, we won't know what you want for your future.

Support for everything that everyone before me said.

Ko te Amorangi ki mua, ki te hāpai ō ki muri.

Don't leave this microphone empty.

7. Wi Huata

Fiscal envelope deals - Waikato and Ngai Tahu, shut the doors on the rest of us.

Ngāti Kahungunu need to hold the line and be firm. Don't compromise us in front of Crown.

Let the rangatahi lead the resistance.

Be proud of yourselves you represent ancestors who fought for and gave up for our people.

Remind them that our people have given to this country, and they want to take more from us.

Noted only: Don't trust Waikato, don't trust Tainui – we want our own people to speak for us. Moved by Wi Huata, noted only.

8. Evelyn Ratima

We will fight.

We've seen the tides turn over the years. What have we learned?

We are resilient people, we still took choices to show that we can still fight for our people, our rights, our voice.

Still the government continue to disregard Te Tiriti.

We can come together and achieve things collectively; we will not stand for anyone else to take that from us.

Marae are our last bastion where we can be ourselves and practice who we are.

It's up to PSGE's to come together and support.

Motion:

We take to government that if you want one people, one nation then let that nation be Māori. Moved by Evelyn Ratima, seconded by Jerry Hapuku and passed by all.

9. Alayna Hokianga-Pouaka

Ahuriri lost 70,000 hectares and we got 1% returned to our people.

Motion:

Te Aka Charitable Trust is requesting Iwi get behind them to save the Conservation house, 59 Marine Pde. Moved by Sarah Greening, seconded by Stephanie [Name], passed by all.

10. Jean Te Huia

Tātere read out email received from Jean.

MWWL along with Ngai Te Rangi are lodging a claim against the government for the proposed policy to remove s7AA from the Oranga Tamariki Act. Ngahiwi Tomoana and Jean Te Huia will be submitting a claim for the same reasons.

Motion:

Ngāti Kahungunu support the claim being lodged against the Crown. Moved by Mereana Pitman and seconded by Raihania Tipoki and passed by all.

11. Jenny Nelson-Smith

We must own the narrative – our narrative.

Karanga to all PSG's that it's our whakapapa that built the platform that you're on. Remember that when making corporate decisions.

Redesign and recreate our own tikanga.

This government is constitutionally unpicking our rights.

It would be important to get some advice from raukura and rangatahi.

Motion:

NKII calls a summit with all PSG's and Taiwhenua to stand shoulder to shoulder based on our intrinsic whakapapa.

12. Sue Paku

Speaker opposes all of governments 100-day action plans.

Reminder Ngāti Kahungunu were the first iwi to introduce a smokefree strategy.

47000 signatories to smokefree repeal petition.

Huhana is lodging an application to the health select committee and Marama with the Māori selection committee and asking that anyone associated with Māori provider or health organization to put their names to the application.

We don't want our mokopuna to take up smoking.

Motion:

Ngāti Kahungunu along with any other organisation, individual or whānau to support the application being made by Huhana Lyndon and Marama Davidson to the Health Select Committee for a smokefree Aotearoa. Moved by Sue Paku and seconded by Wi Huata, pass by all.

13. Koro Te Whaiti

Motion

Kahungunu support the request that Waitangi Marae and Tiakitai Marae be added to the Heretaunga/Tamatea Settlement Trust. Moved by Koro Te Whaiti and seconded by Ana Te Whaiti, passed by all.

14. Ana Te Whaiti

People feel fearful of us because we walk our whenua, wave our flags etc. We need to unite as a people – kotahitanga. Let's be in support of each other.

Check ourselves first.

It's not about putea it's about kaupapa, if we take the putea out, let's see who turns up.

15. Heather Skipworth

Reminder to whānau if you want to learn the reo you can enter at any time.

We need to hold all Māori in the coalition to account in a respectful manner. Hold them to account.

The other people we need to hold account are the opposition, every single place and opportunity.

Three years is too long.

Motion:

Iwi to create and spearhead submission templates for whānau. Moved Zack Makoare,

Noted: Government is to be back-office support only.

16. Haora Hema

There's no stopping us now, this government is trying to assimilate us and erase us.

Motion:

- 1. NKII to issue a statement of no confidence in this government,
- 2. That Ngāti Kahungunu never ceded sovereignty to the crown.

Whakapapa – it is very important to know who we are, who our people are.

Pay love and recognition for the work that others have down before us.

Our tīpuna didn't sign the mana to the Kawana they signed for their hapū.

Make sure that our children and those to come are free from this raru.

18. Bronson Edwards

We need to stand like our maunga especially in times like these.

We need to embrace change and move forward in unity.

They educated our sovereignty out of us, it's time to take it back.

Motion:

NKII holds rangatahi wānanga so rangatahi can speak and be heard by governance. Moved by Bronson Edwards, seconded by Meka Whaitiri and passed by all.

19. Hera Hutana

Don't forget our gang members.

It's time for us to step up and lead our whānau correctly so we can all work together as one.

20. Ngaio Tiuka

Motion:

Kahungunu support the stance that the mana, mauri and health and wellbeing of our water is paramount and that we make the statement to the government to leave Te Mana o Te Wai alone. Moved by Ngaio Tiuka, seconded by Nema Bartlett and passed by all.

We cannot let our Pākeha counterparts trample on us. We need to forget our own little issues happening on our marae and standfast with this kaupapa.

22. Irihapeti Roberts

No comments recorded.

23. Narelle Huata via Tātere

No motion to record. Narelle expressed that Te Tiriti is upheld as a founding document, and that Bayden is supported to reaffirm our stance on the Treaty, which has been covered in other motions.

24. Piripi Winiata

You will never stand alone in the fight, for you will have the light of your ancestors shone upon you - Moana Jackson.

Rangatiratanga is not found in Wellington, rather it is in all of us. Give your children our values, education, pūrākau, Māori ways of being - that is where your rangatiratanga is.

There are two paths our motions sit in:

- 1. Rangatiratanga We rely on ourselves, as Ngāti Kahungunu, and our tino rangatiratanga for those motions that we can empower.
- 2. Kāwanatanga Partnership with the government for motions that rely on that partnership.

Mātāmua ko te rangatiratanga

Rangatiratanga should drive kāwanatanga.

We should create a rangatiratanga strategy that can be used by iwi chair when engaging with the government, whichever government - central or local.

Motion:

Ngāti Kahungunu develop a Kahungunu Rangatiratanga strategy, our people's expectations. Moved by Piripi Winiata and seconded by Mereana Pitman.

25. Renata Hakiwai

Motion:

NKII create advisory taumata to support iwi chair across the spectrum, to help advance Iwi priorities. Moved by Renata Hakiwai, seconded by Kirsty Harrison and passed by all.

26. Safari Hynes

Educating our people through a six-point strategy

- 1. Free resources on websites.
- 2. 6-week online courses on Te Tiriti and He Whakaputanga.

- 3. Marae and hapū to host wānanga.
- 4. Experts are willing to deliver.
- 5. Create a curriculum re: Ngāti Kahungunu position and Te Tiriti.
- 6. The declaration of rangatiratanga has to come from where it resides. Has to come from marae and hapū. Mana Motuhake resides with the people.

27. Meka Whaitiri

Stressed the importance of Hapūtanga.

Motion:

Recognise the sovereignty rights and responsibilities of our marae. Moved by Meka Whaitiri, seconded by Beverley Harmer, passed by all.

Motion:

Ask all Kahungunu to wānanga to look at devolving resources to hapū and to report back on progress. Moved by Meka Whaitiri, seconded by Mereana Pitman, passed by all.

28. Raihania Tipoki

Colonisation is about extracting, reo, resources te mea, te mea.

We need to learn about our complicity in holding up colonial structures. When we support the use of resources extracted from oppressed people.

We need to start building our own systems and be prepared.

When we are self-reliant that's rangatiratanga.

Motion:

Ngāti Kahungunu support any hapū that want to return to their whenua – create a strategy and implement. Moved by Raihania Tipoki, seconded by Ihaia Rolo and passed by all.

Motion:

Ngāti Kahungunu actively object to any mining, marine and terrestrial. Moved by Raihania Tipoki, seconded by Meka Whaitiri, passed by all.

29. Raina Ferris

Draw on our ancestral narratives, learn about and reinstate that mātauranga that derives from our oriori, karanga, waiata, pūrākau.

The answer to our problems is within ourselves and it is doing something about it at the whānau level.

We are the sovereigns. The sovereign is me.

Motion:

Should the government try to stop anything that enhances the mana of wāhine, Ngāti Kahungunu should respond. Moved by Raina Ferris, seconded by Wendy Hynes and passed by all.

30. Zack Makoare

Motion:

Make sure our people get good, warm housing.

Establish a learning institution to support whānau into social and health professionals. Moved by Zack Makoare, seconded by Koro Te Whaiti.

31. Wikitoria Brown

Ask that NKII do everything and anything to strengthen our iwi.

That Ngāti Kahungunu do not get pushed into the Māori box to appease government. Bring Kahungunu back to Kahungunu.

32. [Young wahine in green top]

Would like to see a rest home for Māori that is conducive to who we are.

When the hospital moves, support the returning of the hospital land back to hapū. Shared concerns about the support whānau receive in the hospital and acknowledged that many whānau don't know where to go or what to tap into.

Would like NK to support a kaupapa ward at the hospital.

33. Charmaine Pene

No motions tabled.

34. Tawhana Chadwick

Implement along with our education plan to include education on the doctrine of discovery.

We need a symbol for our movement.

Use the waka, Te Matau a Māui, in rights movements.

35. Sharlene Smith (Toa)

We need to talk to the relevant partners. Government needs to come up to us to talk about the laws and show us what they've got, and we tell them what we already have. What are the next steps from here?

No motions tabled.

36. Leanne Makea

Tono to the iwi to support our athletes by purchasing a dedicated facility. We have high representation of Māori Athletes in our communities. Current sporting grounds, clubs and facilities are not welcoming for Māori.

37. Teiti Hapuku

He Whakaputanga is a way forward. We are the authority.

Motion:

Each Iwi provides cultural safety for kaimahi working in government.

Establish a 'body' that has eyes on policies, bills, and legislation.

Closing korero: Mereana Pitman.

Hui closed: Bayden Barber, Chairperson Ngāti Kahungunu Iwi Incorporated.

Ngāti Kahungunu Hui-A-Iwi

16 December 2023

Waimarama Marae

This loosely structured report is a summary of the feelings and opinions of whānau who did not stand to speak but shared their whakaaro with notetaker, Alicia. It is to be attached with the minutes of the Ngāti Kahungunu Hui-A-Iwi held on 16 december 2023, at Waimarama.

Two questions were asked of whānau:

- 1. Are you aware of the changes the new government has planned?
- 2. How do you feel about those changes?

Many whānau did not know about all the new proposals put forward by the coalition but shared their thoughts and feelings about what they did know. Their korero has been summarized below by theme.

Kotahitanga

The call for unity among all Māori is a priority where we tautoko each other and share expertise. Some whānau expressed that it would take every kaihoe to row our waka to emancipation for all Māori and for Ngāti Kahungunu. Others expressed that a call for unity has been ongoing for years and people are only just waking up to it now.

"We need to let go of the raru and aroha tētahi ki tētahi." "We sing Tūtira Mai but we don't live it." "Our moko need to see us together."

The need to stop being selective about who we let in to help us achieve what Ngāti Kahungunu needs was a strong talking point among some pakeke.

There was the notion that it was time the iwi leaders across Aotearoa came together to issue a statement of solidarity in the face of adversity by the government.

Mamae

An overwhelming majority of people who were asked how they felt regarding the changes proposed by the incoming government spoke of grief - one participant expressed how they felt they were being suffocated by the proposals.

"They hate us, they really hate us." "It feels like we have targets on our backs." "I am being forced to be disconnected.." "I'm angry, we must prepare to fight."

A couple of participants commented that they felt like this undoing by the government was an attempt to degrade us on a national and international level, putting us back into the corner to die off.

Rangatiratanga

Some participants had ideas about how we can strengthen our pre-existing rangatiratanga:

- Learn te reo, make room for te reo Māori
- Workshops that help everyday people to tap into funding opportunities (Te Mātāwai) that uplift whānau rangatiratanga
- Educational resources about our haukaenga that can be used at home or in school to teach ourselves the pūrākau, the colonial history of te rohe o Kahungunu - so we know what we are fighting for.
- Whānau planning/hauora planning that is run through Taiwhenua/PSG

"I am rangatiratanga." "The government doesn't determine my future."

Whānau are mostly comfortable and confident in their rangatiratanga and proud to be Ngāti Kahungunu.
