Schedule (also see separate Draw for team details)

1. 7.30am Team Captains briefing (Volleyball Gazebo)
2. 8.00-10.00am Each team will play 4 matches within 1 of 4 pools (ABCD)
 - a. Pool A – Orange (teams 1-8)
 - b. Pool B – Green (teams 9-16)
 - c. Pool C – Blue (teams 17-24)
 - d. Pool D – Purple (teams 25-32)
3. 10.00am Cross overs for the top 16 teams – posted on board. (bottom 16 teams tournament completed)
4. 10.15am Quarter finals for top 8 teams (bottom 8 teams crossover games)
5. 10.30am Semi-finals for top 4 teams (bottom 12 teams – final placing games)
6. 12.40pm Splash Planet Sand Court – Playoff match for 3rd and 4th
7. 1.00pm Splash Planet Sand Court – Finals Match for 1st and 2nd
8. 1.30pm Splash Planet Sand Court - Prize Giving Ceremony

Competition Rules (and scoring points)

1. Each match will last 14 minutes with a 1 minute break in between to move to the next games
2. Your aim is to accumulate as many points as possible (not to win games)
3. Each game will be played first to 25pts before changing sides or to 12minutes (whichever is sooner)
4. Every serve equals 1 point. Each team will be awarded the points they scored during the whole round i.e. A & B managed to play 2 games during the 12 minute period. Over the 2 games A scored 29 pts and B scored 18 pts. That will be their total points for that round (not who won the games)
5. Every point scored will count towards the team rankings at the end of round 4 (10.00am). The team with the highest accumulated points at that stage will be ranked 1st, second highest accumulated points ranked 2nd, 3rd 4th etc.
6. Crossover games will determine the top 8 teams, then the top 4 teams. Please keep checking the board for your ranking.
7. The 3rd - 4th playoff and the 1st – 2nd final will be played on the sand inside Splash Planet and will be the best of 3 games. Each game will be up to 25 points.
8. The winning team is required to attend the prize giving at 1.30pm to accept their prize.

Vehicles & Parking

1. Each team will be issued 1 vehicle pass (on the day – come to get it from the registration gazebo) to come onto the grass area for parking. I suggest that this vehicle be allocated for gear and kaumatua. The access way is via the main car park to the right side of the Windsor Pool building.
2. Maori Wardens will be monitoring all vehicles entering this space. You must keep this pass displayed on your dashboard at all times to remain in this area. Non-displaying vehicles **WILL** be towed at the owner's expense
3. Other vehicles may park in the main car park or on the street along Grove Road

Refs/Score Keepers

1. Each team is required to provide 1 ref or score keeper for the game immediately after you play (on that same court).
2. Please ask assigned refs to bring their own whistles. None will be supplied on the day.
